Duties & Responsibilities:

Assistant Coach:

1. Attend all trainings scheduled by the Head Coach.
2. Assist with method of conducting the training session, which will be at the discretion of the Head Coach, after consultation with assistant coach/s any specialist or trainee coach/s
3. Assist the Head Coach with making sure the facilities & playing surface is safe to use and clean of hazardous materials, i.e. sticks, rocks, hose.
4. Assist the Head Coach with the regular fitness training's
5. Carry out any duties as set down by the Head Coach after consultation
6. Assist any Specialist Coach that the Head Coach may call on from time to time.
7. Ensure physical contact with a player is appropriate to the situation & necessary for the player's skill development. Inappropriate physical contact is a form of sexual harassment.
8. Refrain from initiating a relationship with a player & also discourage in a sensitive manner, an attempt by a player to initiate a relationship with you.
9. All Officials and Players of a touring party **MUST TRAVEL** as a team. [exception Open Men /Women due to work commitments]
